Eureka! Cowl

This yarn and this pattern couldn't be more perfect for each other!

The yarn randomly self-stripes, showing off the chevron stitch pattern. The zigzag edges accent the tube shape. One skein is all you need for this bold neckwarmer.

Sizes and measurements:

5.5 inches (14cm) tall, 20.5 inches (52cm) around, sized to allow for 2-3 inches (5-7.5 cm) of space between neck and scarf on a woman's neck

Materials:

frabjous fibers “Hand Picked: Stripe”: 1 skein

100% recycled silk; approx. 100 yd per 100g skein

Note: This cowl will use every bit of 1 skein, if you prefer a taller or wider cowl buy an additional skein. If you swatch, you will need to unravel it and use the yarn.

Needles:

US size 8 (5mm), 16” (40.5cm) circular needles (or needle size needed to get the proper gauge)

Notions:

yarn needle

Gauge: 14 sts = 4 inches (10cm) in stockinette stitch

Alternate idea: This pattern also makes a snug head-warmer! Work as above, but stop the stitch pattern earlier to make it 2-3 inches (5-7.5cm) shorter in length.

Pattern instructions:

With circular needle, CO 92 sts. Join in the round, taking care not to twist. Place marker.

Work garter stitch in the round for 4 rounds: Knit 1 round, purl 1 round, knit 1 round, purl 1 round—2 ridges made. Knit one round, then begin stitch pattern below:

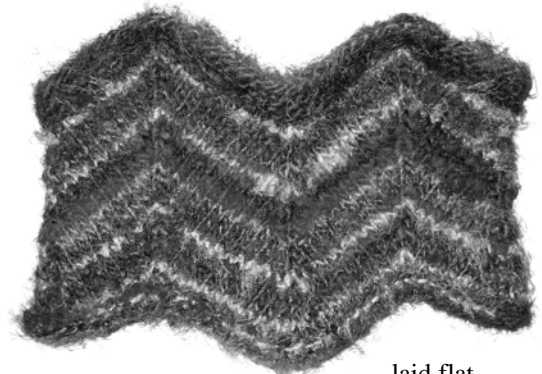
Round 1: *K1, M1, K9, (sl2, K1, pss0), K10, M1, repeat from * 4 times.

Round 2: Knit.

Repeat rounds 1 & 2 for approximately 4 inches (10 cm) from start of stitch pattern. Purl 1 round, BO purlwise.

Note: This cowl is designed to have an top and bottom. If you prefer the top and the bottom to be the same, stop the stitch pattern just short of 4 inches and work garter stitch in the round for 4 rounds starting with a purl round. Bind off.

Weave in ends.
