Sizes and measurements:

the basics (smaller bag shown): 12 inches across
a bundle (larger bag shown): 18 inches across

the basics...

yarn:

[MC] frabjous fibers Banana Silk: 1 skein
100% rayon from banana trees;
150 yd per 200g skein; color: Teal, #14

needles:

1 set(s) US #9/5.5 mm double-point needles (or optionally use a circular needle)
24 inch US #7/4.5 mm circular needle (or needle size needed to knit at a tight gauge)

a bundle...(pattern instructions in parenthesis)

yarn:

[MC] frabjous fibers Banana Silk: 3 skeins
100% rayon from banana trees;
150 yd per 200g skein; color: Vine, #5

[CC] frabjous fibers Sari Ribbon: 1 skein
silk, etc; 25 yd per 50g skein; color: multi

needles:

30 inch US #7/4.5mm circular needle (or needle size needed to knit at a tight gauge)

Notions: 15-20 yds of waste yarn a little heavier than the Banana Silk (or a finer yarn, used with multiple strands together); 4 stitch markers; yarn needle, large focal button; 2, 1.25 inch D-rings (for ribbon strap on “a bundle”); sewing thread in yarn color (for ribbon strap on “a bundle”)

Gauge: 16 sts/22 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch (firm fabric is more important than gauge)

Pattern instructions:

Side one: With waste yarn and size 7 circular needles, use a provisional cast-on and CO 144 (216) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit, place markers as follows: k 24 (36) sts, pm, k 32 (48) sts, pm, k 32 (48) sts, pm, k 24 (36) sts.

Row 2 and all WS rows: sl 1 pwise, purl to last st, k 1.

Row 3 and all RS rows: sl 1 kwise (edging) ; sl 1, k1, p1sso; *knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, pm, K2tog*, repeat from * to * end K2tog, K 1. (10 sts decreased)

Work rows 2 and 3 until 4 sts remain before the first marker. Then work as follows:

Row 4 and all WS rows: sl 1 pwise, purl to last st, k 1.

Row 5: sl 1 kwise; sl 1, k1, p1sso; knit to 1st marker, pm, *K2tog, knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, pm*, repeat from * to *, at last marker: pm, k1, k2tog, k1.

Row 7: sl 1 kwise, SSK, pm, *K2tog, knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, pm*, repeat from * to *, end K2tog, K1.

Row 9 and all RS rows: sl 1 kwise, k 1, pm, *K2tog, knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, pm*, repeat from * to *, end K2.

When 3 sts remain between the center markers, work 1 more purl row removing markers as you go.

Cut yarn leaving 1.5 foot long tail, pull through remaining sts to bind off (turn the 1st st as you thread the yarn through it). Use tail to sew center closed, if necessary.

Gusset: Recover 144 (216) sts from provisional cast-on.

Next row (RS): sl 1 kwise, knit to end.

Then (WS): sl 1 pwise, purl to last st, k 1.

Side Two: Now work as for side one, beginning with Row 1.

I-cord Strap: Pick up 3 (4) sts at the crest of the gusset with the size 7 circulars. With yarn double, use size 9 doublepoints and work 3 (4) st i-cord for 5 (14) inches. Sew to opposite side.

Sari Ribbon Strap: With 3 strands of Sari Ribbon held together measure out a 8 foot length. (You may wish to pick and choose sections of the ribbon that best coordinate with your bag color.) Wrap one end around one D-ring and finger chain a strap 14 inches long. Pull ends through loop to bind-off and use tail to secure to second D-ring. Weave in ends.

Use sewing thread doubled and sew D-ring at the crest of either side of the gusset. Fold the crest over the flat edge of the D-ring and sew into place.

Finishing:

Sew on button. Use leftover yarn to chain a button loop in a size to fit your button. Sew in place.
